For instances of multiple articles with the same authors and years of publication, please check the APA publication manual or Academic Writer. If you have the DOI for the journal article, you should include it in the reference, otherwise, it is not necessary.

Using references in text For APA, you use the authors' surnames only and the year of publication in text. If you are using a direct quote, you will also need to use a page number. If you are using the authors' names as part of the sentence, normal sentence rules apply - always use "and", and never use an "&".

The "APA style" is an author-date style for citing and referencing information in assignments and publications. This guide is based on the "Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association" 6th edition (2010). Always check with your lecturer or tutor about the bibliographic style preferred by the School. There may be differences in the style recommended by the School.

About APA 6th - APA 6th referencing style - Library Guides ...

Bibliographic references are double-spaced and indented half an inch after the first line. If there is no author, the article title comes first. For titles of newspapers, use italics and "headline" style capitalization. Use the URL of the homepage of the newspaper to avoid non-working URLs.
