In 1904 he became pastor of Westminster Chapel in London, England. There were many requests that his sermons be made available in printed form. Each week Dr. Morgan chose one of his weekly messages for publication. At the end of the year they were bound under the title The Westminster Pulpit. I have 10 of those volumes. The lessons in Blessings of The Holy Spirit draw heavily on that body of work. They loosely follow his outlines and make use of his matchless word studies. I first taught them in Fort Worth, Texas, in 2009. My life has been greatly enriched by Dr. Morgan's scholarship and by the insight the Holy Spirit gave to him.
