World Handicap System 2020 - Slope Ratings for Golf Clubs ...

Course rating tells scratch golfers how difficult the golf course will be; slope rating tells bogey golfers how difficult it will be. To put it another way: USGA Course Rating tells the best golfers how hard a golf course actually plays; USGA Slope Rating indicates how much harder the course plays for "regular" (meaning not among the best) golfers. The minimum slope rating is 55 and the maximum is 155 (slope does not relate specifically to strokes played as course rating does). The higher ...

What do golf course rating and golf course slope mean ...

Course rating is a very important part of the USGA Handicap System and is used in calculating a golfer's handicap index. A course rating of 74.8, for example, means that scratch golfers are expected to post an average score of 74.8 playing from that set of tees on that golf course.

Course Ratings In Golf: What the USGA Number Means

Course rating is the starting point. Every golf club is course and slope rated from every set of tees, and then there are separate ratings for men and women. This means that when you go to play a different golf club, your handicap index is actually based on a course of standard difficulty, rather than your home course.

Everything you need to know as golf's World Handicap ...

The USGA Course Rating system looks at each landing zone for both scratch and bogey golfers. There's a designated shot length for men and women. Nearly a dozen different calculations are made on every single hole.

USGA Course Rating: How does it work and why does it ...

The course rating measures the relative difficulty of a golf course. The higher the course rating (expressed as a number such as 69.7), the more difficult the golf course. In other words, golfers would be expected to shoot a higher score on a golf course with a course rating of 73.1 than a golf course with a course rating of 69.7.

Golf Basics: Course Rating and Slope Rating Explained ...

As we're only too well aware, a round of golf - whether that's because of conditions, the weather or how a course is set-up - can be very different from day to day. The Playing Conditions Calculation looks at whether "playing conditions on the day differed from normal conditions to the extent that an adjustment is needed to compensate," the Rules of Handicapping state.

World Handicap System explained: What is the Playing ...

The course rating is produced by considering the number of strokes a scratch player would be expected to complete a round in under normal playing conditions. Scratch, by the way, does not mean tour pro. It's your average club zero-handicapper. The bogey rating, similarly, is the number of strokes a bogey player would take in the same conditions.

Slope Rating: What is it and how ... - National Club Golfer

It has been developed by The R&A and The United States Golf Association (USGA), supported by the world's handicapping authorities, including CONGU, which represents the four home countries of Great Britain and Ireland. To make the game more enjoyable, the new system will include: Course rating and slope rating

World Handicap System (WHS) - England Golf

A Course Rating represents the expected score for a scratch player (Handicap Index of 0.0) under normal playing conditions, while a Bogey Rating represents the expected score for a bogey player (Handicap Index 20.0 to 24.0).

The R&A - Course Rating - The Royal and Ancient Golf Club ...

If a golf course has a bogey rating of 92.1 and a course rating of 70.1, subtract 70.1 from 92.1 for a difference of 22. Multiply the difference between course rating and bogey rating according to gender. For male golfers, multiply the difference by 5.381; for women, multiply it by 4.24 and round to the nearest whole number.

When the slope rating system was first put into effect, the USGA set the slope for an "average" golf course at 113; however, not many 18-hole golf courses have slope ratings that low. Some do, but the real-world average is higher than 113. (However, a slope of 113 is still used in certain calculations within the handicap system.)

Slope Rating@ An indication of the relative difficulty of a golf course for players who are not scratch players compared to players who are scratch players.The lowest Slope Rating is 55 and the highest is 155. Example:125
