Fill a dye pot with room temperature water and place on a heating source, then add the dissolved detergent to the dye pot. Stir well. Add the fiber to the dye pot and slowly bring the temperature to 180°F, rotating the fibers gently, being careful not to tangle or felt. Hold at 180°F for 30 minutes.

In the above figure, ICI' s Markal process, the dry cloth first passes through trichloroethylene (TCE) in the de-waxing vessel which is divided into number of separate compartments.

How to Scour Your Fabric: Simply wash your fabric, this includes PFD fabric, in the washing machine in hot water with Soda Ash. Do not add any fabric softeners to the wash. If you must dry your fabric do so without any fabric softener sheets. NOTE: Fabric softeners interfere with both natural and synthetic dye uptake.

Scouring is deep cleaning of fabric or fiber. Scouring helps assure even color and good penetration of the dye. Cotton in particular needs scouring, even if it is brand new from the fabric shop, because apparently it is full of hidden waxes and oils. Jennings filed for a patent in 1820 and was granted a patent for the "dry-scouring" (dry cleaning) process he had invented just a year later. Tragically, the original patent was lost in a fire. But by then, Jennings' process of using solvents to clean clothes was well-known and widely heralded.

Whether a maid and an accident really had anything to do with it or not, Jolly used this method when he opened the often claimed first modern dry cleaning shop, "Teinturierier Jolly Belin", in Paris. However a patent for a process called "dry scouring" was filed with the U.S. Patent Office in 1821, four years before Jolly's discovery.

Modern dry cleaning's use of non-water-based solvents to remove soil and stains from clothes was reported as early as 1855. The potential for petroleum -based solvents was recognized by French dye-works operator Jean Baptiste Jolly, who offered a new service that became known as nettoyage à sec —i.e., dry cleaning.

Fill a washing up bowl two thirds full with warm water between 50 C and 60C (use lower temperatures for very fine wool) and add about three good squirts of washing up liquid (about two tablespoons). The warmth helps dissolve the lanolin. Gently put the fleece inside and leave it for just under an hour.

The number of glucose units in case of raw cotton is about 3600. Before subjecting the cotton to dyeing or printing it is necessary to clean its natural impurities (cotton scouring) and to whiten it so that it will lose its natural light yellow colour. After that, we can finally move on to the dyeing stage.
