Postcolonialism seeks to emancipate those living under colonial oppression, give them voice, and challenge discourses and structures that maintain its power (Larsen, 2000). It does not suggest a clear break from a colonial past, but "names and examines the issues that emerge from the exploitative relations of colonialist practices and colonial relations" (Tesoriero and Ife, 2006).
