Because engine removal often means moving the engine forward as well as up, remove the radiator, A/C condenser and header panel at the front of the vehicle. For those with a van or select trucks, you'll probably need to slide the engine much further forward to get it out - requiring that any impediments such as radiators, A/C condensers, header panels, grilles, and even bumpers be removed.

Remove the valve cover on the side of the engine next to the valves. Use a feeler gauge to check the gap between the valve lifter and valve stem with the valve lifter in the relaxed - lowest - position. A typical value is .010 inches. Excessive clearance will require replacement of the valve or valve lifter.

Procedures for removing or installing an aircraft engine usually vary widely with the type of aircraft and the type of engine. Thus, no single list of instructions can be provided as a guideline for all engines. Because of the many types of engine and aircraft installations and the large number of design variations within each type or category, representative examples have been selected to illustrate the most typical installation procedures for reciprocating, turboprop, and turbofan engines.

Removing the cylinder head is straightforward on pushrod engines, but more complicated on overhead-camshaft ones because you have to disconnect the timing belt or chain. Methods vary from one engine to another, so if possible consult a handbook for your make of car to verify all the details. Buy a new head gasket and a new rocker-cover gasket.

8. Don't refit the undertray (if fitted) just yet. Before refilling the engine with the new oil, it is essential to check the oil capacity of the car's engine – adding too much oil can cause catastrophic engine failure. Use a funnel to prevent spills, and

always add oil gradually, checking the dipstick (or any digital readout) as you go.

Haynes How-To: change engine oil and an oil filter

(a) Remove clevis pin and locknut from the eye on the end of each magneto lever. (b) Remove magneto control rod assembly. (c) Install a turning bar, FA-182, or Timing Disc, FA-16-2, on the crankshaft. (d) Turn crankshaft until one of the two screws on the front side of a magneto coupling is on top.

Dismantling and Disassembly

Remove the spark plugs to make the engine easy to turn. Refit the distributor so that the timing marks align as the piston of the timing cylinder approaches TDC on its compression stroke. To check when the piston is approaching top dead centre on the compression stroke, ask a helper to place a thumb over the timing cylinder plug hole.

Remove the timing cover, the timing chain and gears, timing chain tensioner (on some engines), the cam thrust plate, then the front engine plate. Now is also the time to remove the water pump, pulleys and oil pan. Inspect: The cam thrust plate for any signs of wear and replace as necessary.

Wash the cylinder head, combustion chambers and valve ports thoroughly with paraffin, to remove all traces of grinding paste. Dry the head with compressed air from a tyre foot pump, and blow through all oilways and bolt holes. Clean all traces of grinding paste from the valves, remembering to keep them in their removal order.

Removing and grinding valves | How a Car Works

The procedure of mechanically cleaning out carbon deposits entails removal of the cylinder head and then, physically scraping off carbon deposits from the top of the pistons, the combustion chamber and other components (e.g. valves).
