1. Draw up warm (never hot or cold) water with plunger into the syringe, attach to feeding tube and gently work it back and forth to loosen the clog. 2. Pull out as much of the contents of the tube as you can. 3. "Milk" or massage the tube to loosen the residual. 4.

### How to recognize, prevent, and troubleshoot mechanical ...

Taking medicines through your feeding tube 1. If you are using a pump, turn this off 1. Flush your tube with at least 30ml water using a syringe 2. Give medicine through your feeding tube 3. Flush your feeding tube again 4. If a number of medicines are given at once, flush with at least 10ml of water between each one. Notes:

### Your Guide to Tube Feeding at Home

Make sure you are taking the right amount of formula and/or feeding rate. Sit upright or lie at a 45-degree angle (about the height of three pillows) during the feeding and for 30 to 60 minutes after the feeding. Do not lie flat during or just after a feeding. Ask your healthcare professional to review your formula.

The following should be considered when seeking to improve or investigate further: Check bowel function. Minimise any air going into the feeding tube. Appropriateness of feeding regimen, including method, volume, rate, fibre content and concentration of feed. Gut motility agents. Gastric venting. ...

CLOGGED FEEDING TUBE Push warm water into the tube with a 60 mL syringe Gently push and pull the plunger to loosen the clog NOTE: Avoid pulling back on the plunger if you have a J-tube Clamp the tube and let the water "soak" for 15 minutes Try gently massaging the tubing with your fingertips

### NURSES' GUIDE TO TUBE FEEDING - Shield HealthCare

Patients will require a tube if they are unable to swallow safely, putting them at risk of aspiration of food, drink and medicines into their lungs. It is vital that nurses are aware of the complications that may arise when caring for a patient with a PEG tube.

### PEG tubes: dealing with complications | Nursing Times

At RCH, the recommended tube to be inserted for jejunal feeding is the yellow Corflo silastic enteral tube. Six French (6FR) enteral tubes are not recommended as they block easily. For longer term feeding a surgical jejunostomy (PEJ) tube or a gastrostomy-jejunostomy (G-J) tube is usually a more successful route for delivering nutrition support.

### Clinical Guidelines (Nursing) : Jejunal Feeding Guideline

PROTOCOL FOR NASAL JEJUNAL (NJ) FEEDING RATIONALE Nasojejunal (NJ) feeding is the continuous infusion of milk through a silastic tube passed nasally through the stomach into the duodenum or the upper jejunum. The complications of this type of feeding include gut perforation, necrotising enterocolitis and gastric bleeding. In

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### Tube Feeding Troubleshooting Guidelines

Enteral feedings deliver nourishment through a tube directly into the GI tract. They're ordered for patients with a functioning GI tract who can't ingest enough nutrition orally to meet their needs. The feeding tube may stay in place as briefly as a few days or permanently, until the patient's death. (See Indications for enteral feeding.)
